  - b) Consider Shakespeare's "Sonnet 118" as a poem of self-exploration.
  
2. Answer *any one* of the following questions: 1x10= 10
  - a) Analyse the character of Puck in *A Midsummer Night's Dream*.
  - b) Explore the supernatural elements in *A Midsummer Night's Dream*.
  - c) Does the opening scene of Shakespeare's *Macbeth* strike the key note of the play? Discuss.
  - d) Critically examine the use of dramatic irony in *Macbeth*.
  
3. Answer *any one* of the following questions: 1x10= 10
  - a) Write a note on Anglo-Saxon Christian poetry.
  - b) Comment on the importance of Miracle, Mystery and Morality plays in the growth of English drama.
  
4. Answer *any five* of the following questions: 5x2 = 10
  - a) "Good sir, no more of this"— Who says this to whom? What is referred to as "this"?

- b) “My verse your virtues rare shall eternize”— Comment.
- c) “She’s all states, and all princes, I”— What is implied in this line?
- d) What is the ‘miracle’ referred to in Shakespeare’s sonnet 65?
- e) “Drugs poison him that so fell sick of you”— Briefly comment.
- f) “I beg the privilege of Athens”— Who begs the ‘privilege of Athens’ and why? What is the ‘ancient privilege of Athens’?
- g) “Apollo flies, and Daphne holds the chase”— Who are ‘Apollo’ and ‘Daphne’? What does the line signify in the given context?
- h) Name the familiars of the first witch and the second witch in *Macbeth*. What do they signify?
- i) Who is referred to as “Valour’s minion” and by whom? What did the speaker imply?
- j) What did the Second Apparition tell Macbeth?

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
