ONLINE ADMISSION PROCEDURE

- 1. The advertisement for on-line admission to the Undergraduate (UG) Programme for the academic session 2023-2024 will be made as per the notification issued by the Government of West Bengal (vide N.O.354-Edn(CS)/10M-95/14, dated 2 June 2023). Online admission will be made w.e.f 01/07/2023 and be completed by 31/07/2023. The college will provide all the information related to the admission for Undergraduate Programme along with a helpline desk (time specific) through mobile/email in the website in this regard.
- 2. The entire admission process will be made online, strictly based on merit. Prospective students will not be called for counseling or verification of documents during the process of admission. No physical presence will be required at the College.
- 3. Documents to be uploaded by the students while filling up the online application:
 - a. Admit card and Mark-sheet of Madhyamik Examination.
 - **b.** Mark-sheet of Higher Secondary Examination.
 - **c.** Caste Certificate (where necessary).
 - **d.** PH Certificate (where necessary).
- 4. All orders, notifications/ Extant Rules issued by the Government of West Bengal including the notification vide N.O.354- Edn(CS)/10M-95/14, dated 2nd June 2023 are applicable in the matters of admission and reservation rules.
- 5. As per New Curriculum and Credit Framework for Undergraduate Programme, UGC 2022 (as per NEP 2020), the Undergraduate degree programmes of either 3 or 4-year duration, with multiple entry and exit points and re-entry options, with appropriate certifications such as:
- a) A UG certificate after completing 1 year (2 semesters) of study in the chosen fields of study, provided that a vocational course (additional 4 credits) must be completed during the summer term by the students who will exit the programme after securing 40 credits. These students are allowed to re-enter the degree programme within three years and complete the degree programme within the stipulated maximum period of seven (7) years.

- b) A UG diploma after 2 years (4 semesters) of study provided that a vocational course (additional 4 credits) must be completed during the summer term by the students who will exit the programme after securing 82 credits. These students are allowed to re-enter the degree programme within three years and complete the degree programme within the stipulated maximum period of seven (7) years.
- c) A bachelor's degree after a 3-year (6 semesters) programme of study.
- d) A 4-year bachelor's degree (Honours) after a 4-year (8 semesters) programme of study. If the student completes a rigorous research project in their major area(s) of study in the 4th year of a bachelor's degree, then (Honours with Research).

Eligibility for the UG Programmes:

The eligibility here is maintained for the credit structure for UG Degree Programme with Single Major only (attached herewith).

1stYear

Entry 1:- Entry requirement for 1St year 1St semester is successful completion of 10+2/Higher Secondary (12th Grade) or equivalent stage of education from any recognized Board/Council/University.

Exit 1:- Students who opt to exit after completion of the first year and have secured 40 credits will be awarded a UG certificate if, in addition, they complete one vocational course of 4 credits during the summer vacation of the first year. These students are allowed to re-enter the degree programme within three years and complete the degree programme within the stipulated maximum period of seven years.

2nd Year

Entry 2:- Entry requirement is a UG Certificate obtained after completing the 1st year (Two Semesters) of the UG Programme.

Exit 2:- Students who opt to exit after completion of the second year and have secured 82 credits will be awarded the UG Diploma if, in addition, they complete one vocational course of 4 credits during the summer vacation of the second year. These students are allowed to re-enter within a period of three years and complete the degree programme within the maximum period of seven years

3rd Year

Entry 3:- Entry requirement is a UG Diploma obtained after successful completion of two years (Four semesters) of the UG Programme.

Exit 3:- Students who wish to undergo a 3-year UG programme will be awarded UG Degree in the Major discipline after successful completion of three years, securing 124 credits and satisfying the minimum credit requirement as per the credit structure.

4th Year

Entry 4:-An individual seeking admission to a Bachelor's degree (Honors/ Honours with Research) in a specified field of learning would normally have completed all requirements of the relevant Three-year Bachelor's Degree.

Students who secure 75% marks and above in the first six semesters and wish to undertake research at the undergraduate level can choose a research stream in the fourth year. They should do a research project or dissertation under the guidance of a faculty member of the University/College. The research project/dissertation will be in the major discipline.

Exit 4:-

4-year UG Degree (Honours): A four-year UG Honours degree in the major discipline will be awarded to those who complete a four-year degree programme with 164 credits and have satisfied the credit requirements as per the credit structure.

4-year UG Degree (Honours with Research): Students who secure 75% marks and above in the first six semesters and wish to undertake research at the undergraduate level can choose a research stream in the fourth year. They should do a research project or dissertation under the guidance of a faculty member of the University/College. The research project/dissertation will be in the major discipline. The students who secure 164credits, including 12 credits from a research project/dissertation, are awarded UG Degree (Honours with Research).

N.B.:

- 1. In case of equal marks in H.S. results, total marks/percentage of marks of immediately preceding examination is to be taken into account for ranking.
- 2. Best five (5) of the H.S. Subjects must be adopted for calculating the total marks and percentage
- 3. In case wherever only Four (4) subject are offered by any recognized Board/Council etc, as the case may be in H.S or equivalent examination, first Language will be doubled to prepare the merit list on the basis of best five of H.S subjects as stated earlier.

Reservation of Seats:

Reservation of seats will be made as per norms of the Government of West Bengal -SC (22%), ST (06%), OBC-A (10%), OBC-B (7%), EWS (10%), for differently-abled candidates 5% of each category. For differently-abled candidate minimum disability will be considered as per Government rule.

Session Gap:

For admission to the Under Graduate Course (1st year, 1st semester), there should not be a gap of more than 3 years between the year of Higher Secondary/ 10+2 or equivalent Examination and the year of admission to Under Graduate Programme of study i.e 2021, 2022 and 2023. In respect of calculation of marks, no deduction should be made in case of candidates passing out in previous years.
